The addition of a copy machine acquired through the Indigent Defense Discretionary Grant, for court appointed attorneys has been a tremendous success with the attorneys, their assistants and my staff. The digital copier is designated for the exclusive use by the court appointed attorneys. We give them the file of discoverable material, and they make the copies. Because it's "self-serve" the ten defense attorneys and both their, and my staff, no longer have to waste valuable time waiting to use the copier or come back because the copier is down for repairs.

The new high-speed copier saves the county money, by faster and more efficient copying, using less toner and less money spent for repair services. To date the machine has been made over 17,505 copies since purchased in September 2003. We think it was money well spent.
